**English-courses**

We are continuing the focus on English, and all courses will from now on have English as standard content in the curriculum. Previously, we have purchased the courses from an external provider, but from November, we will have the courses delivered from Senai, as part of the package. We hope that this solution will be successful, and will follow up the development closely. English is a must in Rio today and in the future.

### **Important Activities and Events**

The past 6 months have been filled with numerous activities and events, and the team has been quite busy coping with everything:

- ***Seminar organized in cooperation with NBCC: How to train and attract skilled labor***  
The seminar was very successful, with highly profiled speakers like Erling Lorentzen, Ms M. Doréa from Firjan, M.Andrade from Statoil, Mr. Luis Araujo from Aker Solutions, Paulo Rolim from STX OSV and Tommy Nielsen from Karanba. Finally our own student Ana Carolina Sabino gave her update on how her dream is coming true, and our president Halvard Idland gave the closing speech focusing on how we can bridge the gap between the need in the market, and the availability of young people with the eagerness and willingness to learn and contribute in society. Around 65 participated in the event.
- ***Rio Oil and Gas***  
DLW was allowed to have a banner and space at the **Innovation Norway** booth during the ROG in RioCentro, Barra. We were present during most of the event, and had many visitors coming by for information and questions. **Statoil** also provided invitations to our students, and they were very proud and happy to attend the fair.
