Current and previous DLW students got to hone their skills when HR experts from Statoil took them through the do's and don'ts of job searching. The event was hosted by Bola Pra Frente.



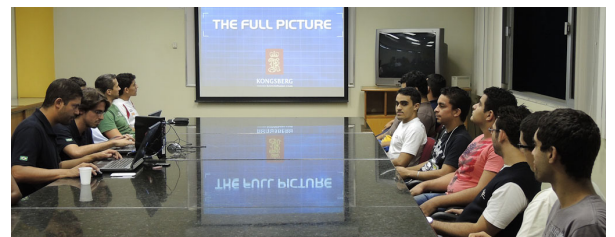
Aker Solutions extended a warm welcome to our students (Macaé)
